ORDINANCE NO. 2017-08

A SUMMARY AMENDING ORDINANCE 2017-01 BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY CONCERNING CODE ENFORCEMENT AND NUISANCE ENFORCEMENT BOARDS

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Oak Grove, Kentucky as follows:

Pursuant to KRS 83A.060 (3), the following is a summary of the City of Oak Grove, Kentucky, Ordinance No. 2017-01

SECTION I. DEFINITIONS.

SECTION II. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP.

There is hereby created pursuant to KRS 65.8801 to KRS 65.8839 and KRS 82.700 to 82.725 within the City, a Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board which shall be composed of ~~(five (5) members)~~ three (3) members and one (1) one alternate, all of whom shall be residence of the city for a period of one (1) year prior to the creation of the board and shall reside there throughout the term in office.

SECTION 4. Appointment of Members; Terms of Office; Removal from Office; Oath; and Compensation.

- a) Members of the Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board shall be appointed by the executive authority of the city, subject to the approval of the legislative body.

The Initial appointment to the board shall be as follows:

1. One (1) member of the board shall be appointed for a term of one (1) year.
2. ~~(Two (2) members of the board shall be appointed for a term of (2) years)~~ One member of the board shall be appointed for a term of two (2) years and;
3. ~~(Three (3) members of the board shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years)~~ One member of the board shall be appointed for a term of three (3) years.


All subsequent appointments shall be for a term of three (3) years. A member may be reappointed, subject to the approval of the legislative body.

The executive authority may appoint, subject to the approval of the legislative body, ~~(two (2))~~ one (1) alternate member to serve on the board in the absence of regular members. Alternate members shall meet all of the qualifications and shall be subject to all of the requirements that apply to regular members of the board.


