

**CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY  
ORDINANCE NO. 2002-03**

**AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY  
REGULATING THE STORAGE AND PARKING OF TRAILERS AND  
COMMERCIAL VEHICLES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recognizes there is currently a problem with the number of commercial vehicles parking in residential areas; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City believes regulation of this type of activity is in the best interests of the City of Oak Grove and its citizens.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY:**

**SECTION I**

(A) No commercial vehicles, nor buses or trailers of any type, including travel, boats, camping and hauling shall be parked or stored on a public right-of-way in a residentially zoned district.

(B) Commercial vehicles are defined for the purposes of this subsection as any vehicle with a rated capacity over two and one-half (2-½) tons or a tractor and trailer.

**SECTION II – UNCONSTITUTIONALITY**

Any and all existing ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed. Should any part of this ordinance be void or unconstitutional, the remaining ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION III – EFFECTIVE DATE**


