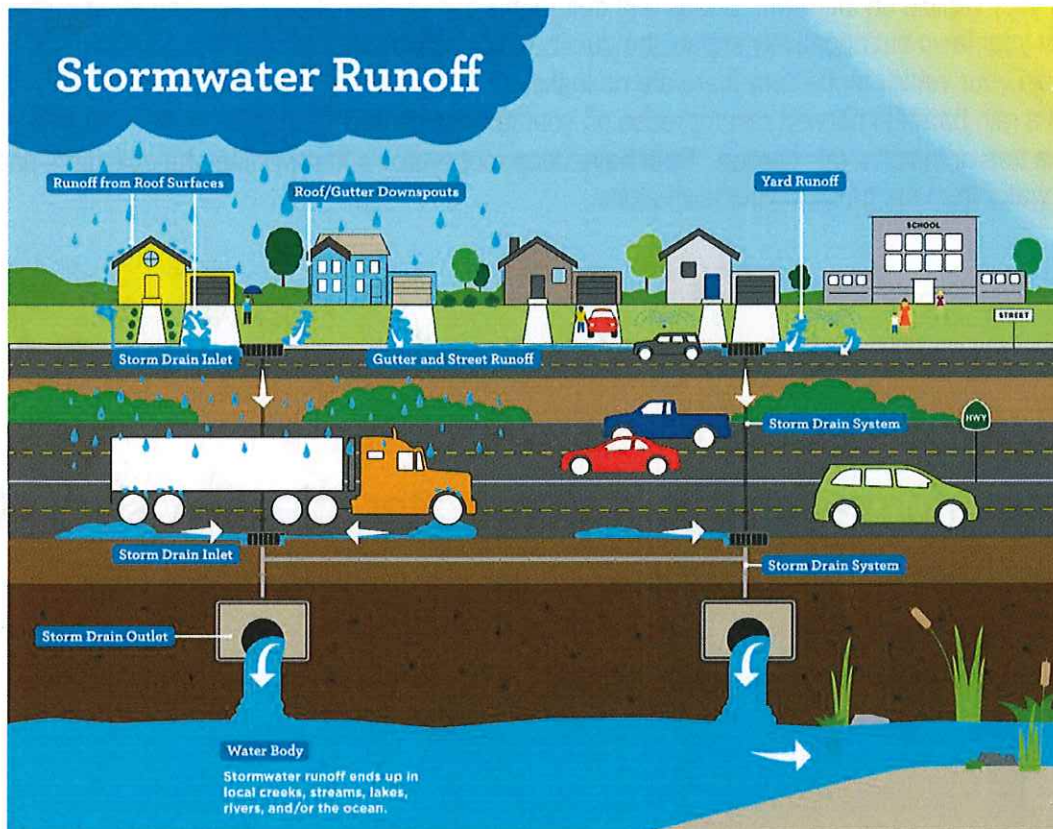

Stormwater



Stormwater is precipitation from either a rain event or snow melt that falls on impervious surfaces, like streets or roofs and eventually flows into storm drains that lead to lakes and rivers.

Water flowing over hard surfaces picks up pollutants along the way. Common pollutants include yard waste, motor oil, trash and salt used during the winter for snow removal. Runoff containing these pollutants and flowing into storm drains is not treated before entering our local water bodies.
