

CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE 2020-01

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY
AMENDING ORDINANCE 2013-08 CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF THE SALE
AND SERVING OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2013, the Oak Grove City Council passed Ordinance 2013-08 regarding the regulation of the sale and serving of alcoholic beverages to comply with changes under state law governing such regulations; and

WHEREAS, since 2013 additional changes to state law regarding the sale and serving of alcoholic beverages have been passed by the Kentucky General Assembly, which requires revisions to the currently existing statute; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE,
KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1

City of Oak Grove Ordinance No. 2013-08, Section 4 shall be amended to read as follows:

The City shall have the power and authority to issue the following kinds of licenses upon proper application and the payment of prescribed fee(s)

A. NQ-1 Retail Drink License, per annum (Combo License/Convention Cntr Only)	\$ 800
B. NQ-2 Restaurant and Motel Retail Drink License, per annum (Combo License)	\$ 210
C. NQ-3 Special Private Club License Retail Drink License, per annum (Combo License)	\$ 300
D. NQ-4 Retail Malt Beverage Drink License, per annum	\$210 \$200
E. NQ Retail Malt Beverage Package License, per annum	\$210 \$200
F. Quota Retail Package, per annum (Distilled Spirits/Wine)	\$ 630
G. Quota Retail Drink License, per annum (Distilled Spirits/Wine)	\$ 630
H. Special Temporary License, per event, (Combo License)	\$ 105

Y. <u>Supplemental Bar License, per annum (The fee for the first (5) supplemental bar licenses shall be the same as the fee for the primary drink license. There shall be no charge for each supplemental license issued in excess of five (5) to the same licensee at the same premises.</u>	

SECTION 2

City of Oak Grove Ordinance No. 2013-08, Section 7 shall be amended to read as follows:

All monies derived from license fees or from fines as provided in this chapter, with the exception of the regulatory license fee imposed on the gross receipts from retail sales of alcoholic beverages, shall be paid to the treasury of the City and become part of the general fund of the City. All moneys derived from the regulatory license fee on the gross receipts from retail sale of alcoholic beverages shall deposited into a segregated fund of the city, spent only for alcohol policing, regulatory, and administrative costs.

SECTION 3

City of Oak Grove Ordinance No. 2013-08, Section 18 shall be amended to read as follows:

~~All renewal of licenses and payment of the license fee must be on file with the ABC Administrator thirty (30) days before the expiration of the licenses for the preceding license period or the license shall be canceled, except that the licensee may file a written, verified statement thirty (30) days prior to the expiration date of the license, setting forth the facts justifying an extension. The ABC Administrator may then extend the time for filing of a renewal of the license for a reasonable length of time within the exercise of his/her sound discretion. The licensee shall pay the license fee from the expiration date of the former license or licenses and payment shall be refunded to the licensee in the event that the license or licenses are not renewed at or before the end of the extension period.~~

(1) Except licenses for special events, temporary licenses, and licenses for alcoholic beverage producers, wholesalers, and distributors, all licenses issued after January 1, 2017, by under this ordinance are valid for a period of no more than one year and are renewable on the date and license year established under KRS 243.090

(2) When any person applies for and is issued a new license authorized under KRS 241 to 244, they shall be charged, if the license is issued, the full fee for the respective license if six months or more remain before the license is due to be renewed, and one-half the fee if less than six months remain before the license is due to be renewed. No abatement of license fees is permitted to any person who held a license of the same kind for the same premises in the preceding license period and who was actually doing business under the license during the last month of the preceding license period.

SECTION 4

City of Oak Grove Ordinance No. 2013-08, Section 23 shall be amended to read as follows:

(A) A regulatory license fee is imposed on the gross receipts from retail sales of alcoholic beverages under each license issued for the purpose of insuring full reimbursement to the City for the cost of additional policing, regulatory, or administrative expenses related to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City. The City Council shall adopt, at the budget adoption for the fiscal year, an annual rate for the regulatory license fee as shall be reasonably estimated to insure full, reimbursement to the City for the cost of additional policing, regulatory, or administrative expenses related to the sale of alcoholic beverages in the City. The regulatory license fee shall be in addition to any other taxes, fees, or licenses permitted by law, but a credit shall be allowed in an amount equal to the cost of the license under the provisions of this chapter.


(B) The regulatory license fee shall be Three Percent (3%) for the fiscal year, beginning and continuing thereafter until amended or repealed.

~~(C) Payment of such fee shall accompany tax returns approved for use by the City Finance Director and a majority of the City Council. The monthly regulatory license fee return shall be submitted to the Deputy Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator and approved for use by City Council. The return shall be submitted to the City Finance Director~~ Deputy Alcoholic Beverage Control Administrator by the thirtieth (30th) day of each month for the preceding month's sales. The fraction, represented by one divided by the number of months for which the city license was issued, of the fee required under the provisions of this chapter shall be deducted each month as a credit.





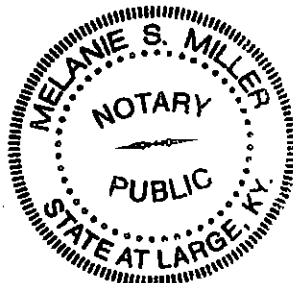
