WHEREAS, this ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority of KRS 381.770 and other applicable law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION TIVE

Establishes penalties, including thes of not less than \$50.00 nor nore than \$250.00 for each offense and establishing civil penalties of not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$500.00 for any person convicted of a second offense in a five to year period. This section also authorizes the City to seek other legal remedies available within the

SECTION SIX

Should any provision, section paragraph, sentence, or any other portion of this ordinance be unconstitutional, invalid, or otherwise unenforceable, such determination shall not impair or affect any other portion of this ordinance, it being the legislative intent to ordain and enact each part of this ordinance independently of all other parts and in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

SECTION SEVEN
This ordinance shall take enect upon passage and publication.
