WHEREAS, a first reading of the Oak Grove Budget Ordinance 2021-07 was held on June 15, 2021, and

WHEREAS, a second reading of the Oak Grove Budget Ordinance 2021-07 was held on June 23, 2021, and

WHEREAS, on the proposed budget showing anticipated receipts of \$8,212,625 and expenditures of \$8,212,625; and

WHEREAS, an annual budget proposal and message has been prepared and delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed said budget proposal and made necessary modifications

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY, that the following budget is adopted for the fiscal year July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022, and the amounts stated are appropriated for the purpose indicated. The mayor is authorized to expend these funds as budgeted without further approval of the City Council.




