# Tuesday, January 18, 2022 Regular City Council Meeting Oak Grove Council Chambers

The Oak Grove City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, January 18, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Oak Grove Council Chambers located at 8505 Pembroke Oak Grove Road, Oak Grove, Kentucky. Present for the meeting were: Mayor Theresa Jarvis, City Attorney Mark Gilbert, Council Member Jean Leavell, Council Member Isaiah Spencer, Council Member Edward Cook, Council Member Jackie Oliver, and Council Member Tim Johnson: Council Member Janet Edwards was absent. Also present was Chief of Police Dennis Cunningham, Public Works Director Martin Nuss, Finance Director Bobbie Crawford, and City Clerk Angela Comperry. There were approximately 5 citizens in attendance.

# **MAYOR'S REMARKS/DEPT HEAD REPORTS**

Finance Director Bobbie Crawford gave council members the monthly financial report. She asked if there were any questions about the report. Council asked if the Water Dept Certificate of Deposit had been moved to the water account and she reported that it had been.

#### **ROLL CALL**

# APPROVAL OF CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

#### **UNFINISHED BUSINESS**

Zoning Fee Ordinance. After discussion, Council Member Jean Leavell made a motion to table the Zoning Fee Ordinance until the last section with C.D.S. It was seconded by Council Member Jackie Oliver. A voice vote was taken with all in favor. Mr. Gilbert stated that the fees were correct.

<u>Ordinance for BZA Board Payment.</u> Council decided to do further research to see if there was a old ordinance that could be amended for BZA board member payment.

<u>Amend ABC Ordinance</u>. Chief Cunningham discussed limiting the number of alcohol licenses within the city and asked council to consider that at some point in the future.

<u>Business License Ordinance</u>. Council Member Jean Leavell made a motion to send the business license ordinance to the Committee of the Whole to update. It was seconded by Council Member Jackie Oliver. A voice vote was taken with all in favor.

<u>Animal Control Ordinance</u>. Council Member Tim Johnson asked that the animal control committee get together with the animal control officer to review the animal control ordinance.

Council Member Jean Leavell made a motion to go into Executive Session. It was seconded by Council Member Jackie Oliver. A voice vote was taken with all in favor.
