Tuesday, March 1, 2022 Regular City Council Meeting Oak Grove Council Chambers

The Oak Grove City Council met in regular session on Tuesday, March 1, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Oak Grove Council Chambers located at 8505 Pembroke Oak Grove Road, Oak Grove, Kentucky. Present for the meeting were: Mayor Theresa Jarvis, City Attorney Mark Gilbert, Council Member Jean Leavell, Council Member Edward Cook, Council Member Jackie Oliver, and Council Member Tim Johnson, Council Member Isaiah Spencer and Council Member Janet Edwards. Also present was Chief of Police Dennis Cunningham, Public Works Director Martin Nuss, Finance Director Bobbie Crawford, and City Clerk Angela Comperry. There were approximately 3 citizens in attendance.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Theresa Jarvis called the meeting to order at 6 p.m.

INVOCATION/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

Pastor Dan Herbster gave the invocation and led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance.

OPEN SESSION

No one signed up for open session.

MAYOR'S REMARKS/DEPT HEAD REPORTS

Mayor Jarvis reported on the City Day/City Night event in Frankfort, lighting at Exit 89 and upcoming road projects and asked council to get involved in the Board of Education to work toward a school for Oak Grove.

Department Head Reports

<u>Fire Department</u>. Chief Johnson reported on surplus equipment from the fire department that will be given to a department in need in Eastern Kentucky. He reported on training on Monday nights for the volunteers and stated that the department had received 100 calls for the year so far.

<u>Public Works</u>. Martin Nuss discussed a group of football and cheerleaders that wanted to use Wades Way park for games that he is working with.

ROLL CALL

Council Members Jean Leavell, Janet Edwards, Jackie Oliver, Tim Johnson, Isaiah Spencer and Edward Cook were present for the meeting making a quorum of the Oak Grove City Council.

APPROVAL OF CITY COUNCIL MINUTES

Council Member Tim Johnson made a motion to approve the council meeting minutes of February 15, 2022. It was seconded by Council Member Isaiah Spencer. A voice vote was taken with all in favor.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS.

<u>Rescue Funds</u>. There was discussion about how the Rescue Fund Grant should be used. Council wanted to hear a report from the city's finance director at the next meeting and wanted to review other possibilities before making any decisions.

NEW BUSINESS

<u>Fire Department Surplus</u>. Council Member Jackie Oliver made a motion to approve the surplus list item from the fire department to be given to another department in need in Eastern Kentucky. It was seconded by Council Member Edward Cook. A voice vote was taken with all in favor.

Council Member Jean Leavell made a motion to go into Executive Session per 61.810 (b) to discuss land acquisition. It was seconded by Council Member Tim Johnson. A voice vote was taken with all in favor.

EXECUTIVE SESSION (KRS 61.810) (b)

Council Member Tim Johnson made a motion to return to open session. It was seconded by Council Member Isaiah Spencer. A voice vote was taken with all in favor.

The mayor announced that no decisions were made in closed session.

LEGISLATIVE BRANCH

There was discussion about putting up new security cameras at Wades Way Park.

ADJOURN

Council Member Tim Johnson made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Council Member Isaiah Spencer seconded the motion. A voice vote was taken with all in favor. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:00 p.m.
