Committee of the Whole Special Meeting Minutes
Oak Grove Council Chambers**

The Oak Grove Committee of the Whole met in special session on Thursday, August 4, 2022, at 6:00 p.m. in the Oak Grove City Council Chambers located at 8505 Pembroke Oak Grove Rd Oak Grove, Kentucky. Occupational License Ordinance No. 2008-05: Discussion was held regarding enforcement, seasonal licenses, internet businesses and other general matters. City Attorney is looking into options for enforcement. No action was officially taken.

Ordinance 2022-XX Compensation Plan:

Council Member Isaiah Spencer recused himself for this discussion. Council requested to amend the current Compensation Ordinance in effect and move the Code Enforcement Officer/Zoning Inspector position from a grade 36 to a grade 37. They also requested to move Major/PD position from a grade 46

to a grade 47 and to bring forth said changes to the next regular council meeting. Council also requested the city implement the step program for the city.
