RESOLUTION #2023-02**

WHEREAS, The City of Oak Grove has experienced damage from severe thunderstorms, severe winter storms, tornadoes and flooding on many occasions in the past century, resulting in property loss, loss of life, economic hardships, and threats to public health and safety;

WHEREAS, the Pennyriple Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan (the Plan) has been comprehensively reviewed and updated by the staff of the Pennyriple Area Development District, the members of the Pennyriple Regional Hazard Mitigation Council, and the people of the community;

WHEREAS, the Plan recommends many hazard mitigation actions that will protect the people and property affected by the natural hazards that face the Pennyriple Area Development District; and

WHEREAS, public meetings were held as required by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and the City Council of Oak Grove that:

1. The Pennyriple Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan has hereby adopted as an official plan of the Pennyriple counties and the jurisdictions within: Caldwell, Christian, Crittenden, Hopkins, Livingston, Lyon, Muhlenberg, Todd, and Trigg.
2. The respective officials identified in the strategy of the Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended actions assigned to them. These officials will report quarterly on their activities, accomplishments, and progress to the Pennyriple Regional Hazard Mitigation Council.
3. The Pennyriple Regional Hazard Mitigation Council will provide annual progress reports on the status of implementation of the Plan to the Mayor and City Council of Oak Grove.
