City of Oak Grove, Kentucky Ordinance No. 2023-XX

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE CITY OF OAK GROVE'S ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2022 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023 BY ESTIMATING REVENUES AND RESOURCES AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND THE WATER ENTERPRISE.

WHEREAS, KRS 424.240 requires that "immediately following the adoption of an annual budget by any city other than one of the first class, the City Clerk shall cause a summary of the budget or the text of the budget ordinance to be advertised for the city by publication in a newspaper"; and

WHEREAS, a first reading of the Oak Grove Budget Ordinance 2023-XX was held on March 21, 2023 and

WHEREAS, a second reading of the Oak Grove Budget Ordinance 2023-XX was held on April 4, 2023 and

WHEREAS, on the proposed budget showing anticipated receipts of \$11,013,450 and expenditures of \$11,013,450 and

WHEREAS, an annual budget proposal and message has been prepared and delivered to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed said budget proposal and made necessary modifications

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY, that the following budget is adopted for the fiscal year July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023 and the amounts stated are appropriated for the purpose indicated. The mayor is authorized to expend these funds as budgeted without further approval of the City Council.
