



Tuesday June 20, 2023 Regular City Council Meeting Minutes Oak Grove Council Chambers

The Oak Grove City Council met in Regular Session on June 20, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Oak Grove Council Chambers located at 8505 Pembroke Oak Grove Road Oak Grove, Kentucky. Present for the meeting were: Mayor Jacqueline Oliver, Council Member Janet Edwards, Council Member Isaiah Spencer, Council Member Jean Leavell, Council Member Richard Baker, Council Member John Campbell, and Council Member Edward Cook. Also present for the meeting were City Attorney Mark Gilbert, Police Chief Dennis Cunningham, Finance Director Bobbie Crawford, Field Operations Manager Brandy Moore, and City Clerk Lorelynn Fisher. There were approximately 7 individuals present at the meeting.

Mayor Jacqueline Oliver called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

OPENING CEREMONIES

Pastor Dan Herd led those present in the Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance

OPEN FORUM

Theresa Jarvis voiced her concerns before the city council regarding Public Works, Code Enforcement, water loss, growth and development, and the Oak Grove Community Center.

Council Member Isaiah Spencer made a motion to accept the ordinance. Council Member Jean Leavell seconded the motion. Discussion was held. Mayor Oliver addressed the city council with her budget message. - Ordinance No. 2023-XX amending Ordinance No. 2023-09 Exhibit 1 of the classification and compensation plan for city employee's 1st reading: Council Member Janet Edwards asked City Attorney to read the changes of said ordinance. City Attorney read the summary of the ordinance aloud. The city council requested this ordinance be put on the special agenda for the June 29, 2023, special city council meeting for its second reading and official vote.

Finance Director Bobbie Crawford addressed the city council regarding money market accounts and the benefits of having one for each fund of the city which includes a 4% interest rate. Council Member Jean Leavell made a motion to move to money market accounts. Council Member Edward Cook seconded the motion. Discussion was held. A voice vote was taken with all present in favor; the motion passed. Crawford also informed the city council of a company that will allow the city to do away with most credit cards machines and residents who want to pay their water bill can do so by calling a 24/7 number to make a payment when the Utilities Department is closed. Residents will be responsible for 100% of the merchant fees for using a card and the city can stop taking a hit from those fees.
