**Regular City Council Meeting Minutes**

The Oak Grove City Council met on April 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Oak Grove Council Chambers located at 8505 Pembroke Oak Grove Road Oak Grove, Kentucky.
