



Tuesday, May 21, 2024 Regular City Council Meeting Minutes Oak Grove Council Chambers

The Oak Grove City Council met on May 21, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was held in the Oak Grove Council Chambers located at 8505 Pembroke Oak Grove Road, Oak Grove, Kentucky. Present for the meeting were: Mayor Jacqueline Oliver, Council Member Jean Leavell, Council Member Richard Baker, Council Member John Campbell, Council Member Janet Edwards, and Council Member Isaiah Spencer. Council Member Edward Cook was absent. Also present for the meeting were City Attorney Lee Wilson, Police Chief Dennis Cunningham, Public Works Director Brian Ahart, Finance Director Bobbie Crawford, and City Clerk Lorelynn Fisher. There were approximately three individuals present at the meeting.

OPEN FORUM
