Whereas, Oak Grove, Kentucky, as a proud community with a strong military presence, recognizes the importance of honoring and supporting the children of military families; and

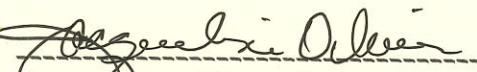

Whereas, the color purple symbolizes the joint service of all branches of the military, representing a unified spirit of support for military families;

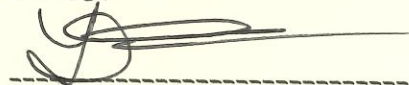
