If you choose to contest the citation and request a hearing before the Code of Ordinance Enforcement Board, the maximum penalty that may be imposed for this violation is \$500.00. Failure to pay the applicable civil penalty or request a hearing, in writing, from the Nuisance and Code Enforcement Board within seven (7) days of the issuance of this citation shall constitute a waiver of your right to contest the citation and the determination that a violation was committed shall be final and nonappealable.

According to Oak Grove Ordinance 2021-13, the Nuisance & Code Enforcement Board shall have the power to issue remedial order and impose civil fines as a method of enforcing city ordinances. The person to whom the citation is issued shall respond to the citation within seven (7) days of the date of issuance by either paying the civil fine or requesting in writing, a hearing before the Nuisance & Code Enforcement Board to contest the citation. If the person fails to respond to the citation within seven (7) days, the person shall be deemed to have waived the right to a hearing and the determination that a violation was committed shall be considered final.

FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER

RE: VIOLATION OF ORDINANCE(S) NO. 2020-06.

The Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board enters the following **FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND ORDER.**

FINDINGS OF FACT

The respondent, WALLACE, MITCHELL, is the owner of property located at 0 Fort Campbell Blvd., Oak Grove, KY 42262 (145-00 00 005.02).

The respondent, WALLACE, MITCHELL, was issued a citation by the Code Enforcement Officer dated August 25, 2025, for violation of City ordinance 2020-06.

The respondent, WALLACE, MITCHELL, neglected to respond to the citation within 7 days as required by KRS 65.8825.

The Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board finds, based on all evidence presented at the Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board Meeting, that the condition described in the citation did, in fact, exist at the time the citation was issued, that the condition did constitute a violation of city ordinance 2020-06, and that the condition was caused by, or was the responsibility of, the respondent WALLACE, MITCHELL, as owner, or persons in charge of the property on which the violation occurred.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The board concludes, based on the foregoing Finding of Fact, that respondent, WALLACE, MITCHELL, has committed a violation of city ordinance 2020-06 of the City of Oak Grove Kentucky, as charged in the citation.

ORDER

It is hereby ordered on 16 day of October 2025, by the Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board, that the Respondent, WALLACE, MITCHELL, shall pay a civil fine to the City of Oak Grove a \$500.00 citation fee, an abatement fee of \$450.00, and \$60.00 administrative/filing fee, totaling a sum of \$1,010.00, plus any interest that may accrue from this date forward. Therefore, a certified copy of this order, together with a claim of lien, shall be recorded in the Office of the County Clerk, and once recorded, along with all charges and fees incurred by the city in connection with enforcement, shall constitute a lien against the property upon which the violation exists, pursuant to KRS 65.8835.
