Fire Chief Bill Johnson: Reported 69 calls for service; 44 hours of training; 28 personnel on the roster.

Community Center Director Eric Hauser: Reported Upcoming events:

- December 19 Living Water Church Community Market
- December 20 Breakfast with Santa

Police Chief Victor Lynch: Reported 1,358 service calls; 22 non-injury collisions; 5 injury collisions; 3 fatalities; 0 overdose calls. Advised residents to exercise caution on roads due to inclement weather and

provided safety tips. He also noted that the school bus situation is improving. Mayor Oliver noted that Oak Grove has issued more tickets than surrounding areas for vehicles not stopping for buses.

Public Works Director Brian Ahart: Reported the following:

- VAC trailer delivered to Public Works to support more efficient operations.
- Skid steer delivered today; backhoe expected later this week. Council members invited to inspect the equipment.
- Paving project delayed due to weather; Oak Grove is next on the schedule.
- Encouraged residents to park vehicles in driveways, if possible, to assist Public Works in plowing roads during inclement weather.
- Baker recognized the Public Works Department for their efforts during the winter weather.
