- Council Member Janet Edwards inquired about missing items at the community center. Mayor Oliver stated the shed at the community center was cleaned out and organized. Edwards also mentioned that she received a message from a resident regarding the poor quality of the audio. Mayor Oliver stated that council should turn the microphones on and speak into them. Council Member John Campbell showed Mayor Oliver an audio system he believes would be more efficient.
- o **Council Member Isaiah Spencer** stated that he, the mayor, and other council members attended an Eye Opener breakfast and expressed displeasure that Oak Grove was not mentioned while other cities were. There was also discussion regarding the Chambers and SWK's presence at a meeting.
