A SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14 OF ORDINANCE 2008-05
AND PROVIDING FOR CIVIL PENALTIES FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE
ORDNANCE AND PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT BY THE CODE AND NUISANCE
BOARD

By summary, this ordinance amends Ordinance 2008-05 section 14 to add a provision establishing a civil penalty for failure to comply with the ordinance. Specifically, the ordinance provides that any violation of the ordinance with a penalty not otherwise specified in the ordinance shall be civil offense and shall be enforced by the Oak Grove Code Enforcement Officer and submitted to the Oak Grove Code and Nuisance Board. A citation for a violation shall only be issued 7 days after receiving a notice of violation. Each days continued violation after receiving a citation shall be a separate offense. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the City from taking any other lawful action in the enforcement of this ordinance and the collection of any taxes owed. The fine shall be in accordance with the following schedule:

- (1) If a citation for a violation of an ordinance is not contested by the person charged with the violation, the penalties set forth in this subsection shall apply:

Violation	1 st offense	2 nd offense	3 rd offense
	\$50.00	\$150.00	\$250.00

- (2) If the citation is contested and a hearing before the Oak Grove Code and Nuisance Board is required, the following maximum penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the Oak Grove Code and Nuisance Board:

Violation	1 st offense	2 nd offense	3 rd offense
	\$100.00	\$300.00	\$500.00
