**AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY
REPEALING ORDINANCES 11-1976,1981-03,1984-06, 1985-01,1986-12,1990-
03,1994-04, 1998-01,1999-16,2000-12, 2001-09,2004-01,2004-11,2005-06, 2008-
02,2008-05, AND 2023-03 RELATING TO OCCUPATIONAL BUSINESS LICENSE
AND TAX.**

WHEREAS, it is in the City of Oak Grove's best interest to repeal all existing occupational business license and tax ordinances of the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2023-08 IS HEREBY READ AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE- REPEALING OF EXISTING OCCUPATIONAL BUSINESS
LICENSE AND TAX ORDINANCES OF THE CITY**

Ordinance No. 11-1976, enacted on 14 day of June 1976, and relating to the regulation of license tax and manner and form of granting and issuing same on the various lines of business, trades, occupations, professions, vocations, and callings in the City of Oak Grove and providing penalties for nonpayment, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 1981-03, enacted on 18 day of July 1981, and relating to the imposition and levying of license fees for the engagement of occupations, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 1984-06 enacted on 13 day of April 1984, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance No. 1981-03, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 1985-01, enacted on 19 day of April 1985, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance 11-1976, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 1986-12, enacted on 12 day of September 1986, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance 11-1976, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

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Ordinance No. 1994-04, enacted on 21 day of January 1994, and relating to the amendment of 110.05(A) of the code of ordinances of the City of Oak Grove, Kentucky, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 1998-01, enacted on 28 day of May 1998, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance No. 11-1976 and all subsequent amendments thereto to be amended by comprehensive revision, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 1999-16, enacted on 7 day of December 1999, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance No. 1998-01, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

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Ordinance No. 2005-06 enacted on 29 day of July 2005, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance Nos. 1981-03, 1984-06, and 1990-03 and requiring employers to pay employee withholdings on a monthly, rather than quarterly basis, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 2008-02 enacted on 21 day of March 2008, and relating to the imposition and administration of an occupational license requirement, and payment of an occupational license tax by persons and business entities conducting businesses, occupations, and professions within the City of Oak Grove, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 2008-05 enacted on 8 day of May 2008, and relating to the imposition and administration of an occupational license requirement, and payment of an occupational license tax by persons and business entities conducting businesses, occupations, and professions within the City of Oak Grove, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 2023-03 enacted on 28 day of March 2023, and relating to the amendment of Ordinance No. 2008-05 section 14 penalties, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION TWO- SAVINGS CLAUSE

Allows prosecution for violation(s) of Ordinance Nos. 11-1976, 1981-03, 1984-06, 1985-01, 1986-12, 1990-03, 1994-04, 1998-01, 1999-16, 2000-12, 2001-09, 2004-01, 2004-11, 2005-06, 2008-02, 2008-05, and 2023-03 on July 1, 2023, as long as the violation(s) occurred while these ordinances were in effect.

SECTION THREE – SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

It is the legislative body's intent that the provisions of this ordinance are to be severable, and that if a part of this ordinance is to be invalid, the findings do not necessarily invalidate the entire ordinance.

SECTION FOUR-EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect on July 1, 2023.

Burks also added 7.5 rebounds per game with 2.9 assists, 1.4 steals and 0.3 blocks. He shot 46.7% from the field, 26.7% from three and 67% from the free throw line.

His prep career earned him three-star prospect status ranking as the 172nd best prospect in the 2023 class nationwide and 39th best small forward.

College Recruitment
The original plan was for Burks to join one of Kentucky's SEC rivals.

In August 2022, Burks committed to Ole Miss to play for head coach Kermit Davis.

"I feel like I can create a second home at Ole Miss and make my mark there while bringing success and a new mental

ity to approaching hard work every day, having high spirits," Burks told 247sports' Inside The Rebels.

"I got to work out with Kermit Davis, to gain experience of the style of play, how they do it. I went straight through it. It was like a breeze. It was normal. That's the system they use and I feel really comfortable about going to Ole Miss."

Burks later signed his national letter of intent with the Rebels, but after Ole Miss struggled during the 2022-23 season, Davis was fired and former Texas head coach Chris Beard was later named as his replacement.

Not long after Beard's hiring, Burks opted to request a release from his NLI and reopen his recruitment.

His final decision came down to Kentucky, Florida and Miami, but it was UK,

his dream school growing up, that won his services.

"I feel confident in my decision because Coach Calipari is genuine," Burks said on an appearance on I Am Athlete, where he announced his commitment Monday. "He's a family guy. He's honest, he doesn't lie. He tells every player the same thing. It's not going to be easy, because if it was easy then everybody could do it. That's why (Kentucky) is the best fit for me, because (Calipari) wasn't promising me any minutes, nothing. Just, 'You've got to come work. You've got to work for what's yours.'"

What The Experts Say
Burks is best known for using his 6-foot-9 frame and 7-foot wingspan to score over defenders and matchup with power forwards and centers on the defensive end.

While he was not a

great outside scorer for Hillcrest, shooting just 26.7% from three, he did put plenty of points on the board and the belief is he could improve as a shooter and overall scorer at the college level.

"Jordan has good size and has the ability to be a prolific scorer," Calipari said. "His length allows him to play multiple positions, be dynamic in the open court, rebound at both ends and he can put it on the floor and score in a variety of ways. Jordan has challenged himself against the best of the best and wanted to continue to be pushed at the next level. I really love his toughness and his upside is tremendous, and that his dream since was young was to play at Kentucky. I'm looking forward to getting in the gym and helping him take his game to

new levels."

"He is at his best in the open court using his size, length and athleticism to get a head of steam and finish above the rim, but

will need to hone in on his half court skillset in the months leading up to the start of the college basketball season," Travis Branham of 247 sports said.

they'll take from it going forward.

"We are really moving the ball well as we continue learning a new offense, the girls have adjusted to that and moving the ball well and finding the open man on that part, so we're executing on that and we're starting to learn where they overplay us in the backdoor and doing different things on offense," Williams said.

Going into the regular season in the winter, Williams said they'll take confidence and that

they have some great players, noting their upperclassmen and that he hopes to get their younger players into the roles of their veteran players throughout the rest of this summer. Some key players he touched on were Abby Williams, who is a shooting guard and will be a senior this season and Alexis Taylor, who is a post player, very aggressive on the inside who can play both in and out and plays very well. It's clear that Williams is confident in the team they have going into the regular season.

"Our team goals is one, to get the team better in sync, playing how we're playing and playing different styles and knowing what each

Brady Givanev pitched five innings and allowed two hits, walked three batters and struck out three.


Jacob Dilday pitched two innings and struck out three batters.
