**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY REPEALING
ORDINANCE 2002-03 RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF STORAGE AND
PARKING OF TRAILERS AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES**

WHEREAS, The City of Oak Grove enacted Ordinance No. 2002-03 relating to the regulation of storage and parking of trailers and commercial vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Section 6.36 of the City of Oak Grove's Zoning Ordinance, No. 2021-11, addresses the same subject matter as Ordinance No. 2002-03; and

WHEREAS, To remove any conflict between the provisions of City of Oak Grove Ordinance No. 2002-03 and City of Oak Grove Ordinance No. 2021-11 relating to the regulation of storage and parking of trailers and commercial vehicles;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY
THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2024-05 IS HEREBY READ AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1-REPEALING OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 2002-03, enacted on the 28 day of February 2002 and relating to the regulation of storage and parking of trailers and commercial vehicles is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2-SEVERABILITY

It is the legislative body's intent that the provisions of this ordinance are to be severable and that if a part of this ordinance is to be invalid, the findings do not necessarily invalidate the entire ordinance.

SECTION 3-UNCONSTITUTIONALITY

Should any part of this ordinance be void or unconstitutional, the remaining ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication according to law.
