**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY, AMENDING
SECTION 5, SUBSECTION B, OF ORDINANCE 2021-13.**

WHEREAS, this amendment revises the scheduled time for the monthly meetings as desired by the Code Enforcement and Nuisance Board.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY
THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2024-22 IS HEREBY READ AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1-AMENDMENT OF SECTION 5, SUBSECTION B OF ORDINANCE 2021-
13**

Section 5. Organization of board; meetings; quorum.

- (a) The code enforcement and nuisance board shall annually elect a chair from among its members. The chair shall be the presiding officer and a full voting member of the board. In the absence of the chair, the remaining members of the board shall select a member to preside in place of an exercise the powers of the chair.
- (b) Regular meetings of the code enforcement board shall be held on the third Thursday of every month at 5:00 p.m. [~~6 p.m.~~] Meetings other than those regular scheduled shall be special meetings or emergency meetings held in accordance with the requirements of the Kentucky Open Meetings Act.
- (c) All meetings and hearing of the code enforcement board shall be public meetings held in accordance with the requirements of KRS 65.8815(5) and the Kentucky Open Meetings Act.
- (d) The presence of at least a majority of the board's entire membership shall constitute a quorum. The affirmative vote of a majority of a quorum of the board shall be necessary for any official action to be taken.
- (e) Minutes shall be kept for all proceedings of the code enforcement board and the vote of any member on any issue decided by the board shall be recorded in the minutes.

SECTION 2-SEVERABILITY

It is the legislative body's intent that the provisions of this ordinance are to be severable and that if a part of this ordinance is to be invalid, the findings do not necessarily invalidate the entire ordinance.

SECTION 3-UNCONSTITUTIONALITY

Should any part of this ordinance be void or unconstitutional, the remaining ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE


