**AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY
ESTABLISHING A CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION PLAN FOR CITY
EMPLOYEES**

WHEREAS, the purpose of the classification plan is to classify all city jobs in accordance with duties, responsibilities, and requirements; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the compensation plan is to recruit and retain employees, and to ensure market/internal structure alignment; and

WHEREAS, the classification and compensation plan will provide for consistent and fair treatment of all employees, and will be free from favoritism, partiality, or discrimination for improper reasons; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the implementation of the classification and compensation plan is in the best interests of the City of Oak Grove, its employees, and its citizens

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY
THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2023-09 IS HEREBY READ AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION ONE—CITY COUNCIL TO PROVIDE PAY GRADE AND RANGE

It shall be the sole responsibility of the Oak Grove City Council to provide pay grades and pay ranges sufficient to provide for continued recruitment and retention of qualified personnel to carry out the goals and objectives established by the Mayor, City Council, and local, state and federal laws. City Council shall review and revise the classification and compensation plan annually based on market analysis and consumer price index.

SECTION TWO-ESTABLISHMENT OF PAY GRADE

A. The pay grade of each job position shall be set by the City of Oak Grove Compensation Table and Position Grade Assignment labeled "Exhibit 1" and incorporated by reference herein;

B. When the duties of a position are changed, it may be necessary to be assigned a different pay grade. Upon recommendation by the Mayor or his/her designee, the City Council shall determine a new pay grade for the position.

SECTION THREE-ESTABLISHMENT OF PAY RANGE

A. The pay ranges of the City shall be as set forth in the City of Oak Grove Compensation Table and Position Grade Assignment labeled "Exhibit 1" and incorporated by reference herein;

B. The classification and compensation plan shall be amended, suspended, or repealed only by a change of ordinance.

SECTION FOUR-ESTABLISHMENT OF PAY LEVEL WITHIN A PAY GRADE

Within the pay grades set by the City Council and within the city's annual budget for salaries, it shall be the sole responsibility of the Mayor, based on the recommendation of appropriate supervisors, to establish the pay level of all city employees.

SECTION FIVE-ESTABLISHMENT OF MANPOWER LEVEL

Manpower levels for each department shall be determined through the annual budget ordinance.

SECTION SIX-ADMINISTRATION OF CLASSIFICATION AND COMPENSATION PLAN

Regulations for administering the City's classification and compensation plan will be contained in the city's personnel policies, which are adopted by municipal order by City Council.

SECTION SEVEN- SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

It is the legislative body's intent that the provisions of this ordinance are to be severable, and that if a part of this ordinance is to be invalid, the findings do not necessarily invalidate the entire ordinance.


SECTION EIGHT-EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication according to law.





For this US Open in LA, fairways look wider than they really are

LOS ANGELES — Rickie Fowler was walking toward his golf ball in the 18th fairway on a cool, cloudy Sunday afternoon when he looked to his right and to his left and asked a most unusual question for any U.S. Open but this one.

"Are these the widest fairways for a U.S. Open?" he said.

There's a lot different about a U.S. Open at Los Angeles Country Club, and that goes beyond the second-oldest championship in golf being held on the edge of Beverly Hills.

The U.S. Open hasn't had Bermuda rough in play off the fairways since 2005 at Pinehurst No. 2, and yet the greens on the North course are benign.

As for the fairways? True, this is one of the widest U.S. Open courses. But it might help to put a notice several tee boxes that says, "Targets are smaller than they appear."

"Looks big," Fowler said. "Plays small."

CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2023-07
A SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE IMPOSITION AND ADMINISTRATION OF OCCUPATIONAL BUSINESS LICENSE REQUIREMENT, AND PAYMENT OF AN OCCUPATIONAL BUSINESS LICENSE TAX BY PERSONS AND BUSINESS ENTITIES CONDUCTING BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY.

By summary, this ordinance replaces Oak Grove's ordinance providing for business license and occupational license tax. Specifically, it amends the gross profits occupational license tax, consolidating the three previous definitions of business types with different tax rates with a single rate for all businesses. All sections of the previous business license ordinance, other than Section 3(A), remain the same. Section 3(A) is being amended to read as follows:

SECTION THREE - OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAX PAY: EXCEPT AS PROVIDED

A. Except as provided in subsection (B) of this section, every person or business entity engaged in any business for profit and any person or business entity that is required to make a filing with the Internal Revenue Service or the Kentucky Revenue Cabinet shall be required to file and pay to the City an occupational license tax for the privilege of engaging in such activities within the City.

1. The occupational license tax shall be 1.5% of all wages and compensation paid or payable in the City for work done or services performed or rendered in the City by every resident and nonresident who is an employee.
2. The occupational license tax shall be measured by the gross receipts from business conducted in the City by a resident or nonresident business entity as follows:
All businesses: .25% or .0025
3. The minimum payment for an occupational license is \$100.00.
4. All gross profit returns will be based on the business calendar year and of fiscal year end, and due as provided in Section 6 (A). By the 15th day of the fourth month following the close of the fiscal year.

WHEREAS, it is in the City of Oak Grove's best interest to repeal all existing classification and compensation plan ordinances of the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2023-10 IS HEREBY READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE - REPEALING OF EXISTING COMPENSATION PLAN ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 1989-5, enacted on 21 day of July 1989, and relating to the implementation of the classification plan and policies and procedures, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Ordinance No. 2001-01, enacted on 24 day of February 2001, and relating to the compensation plan for city employees, is hereby repealed in its entirety.


