**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY REPEALING
ORDINANCE 2002-18 ESTABLISHING THE PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN
UNCONTROLLED NOISES**

WHEREAS the city council deems it necessary and in the best interest of the city to repeal this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY THAT ORDINANCE NO. 2025-14 IS HEREBY READ AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1-REPEALING OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 2002-18, enacted on the 27th day of August 2002, establishing the prohibition of certain uncontrolled noises, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2-SAVINGS CLAUSE

Permits prosecution for violations of the ordinances listed in Section 1, provided the violation(s) occurred during the period the ordinances were in effect.

SECTION 3-SEVERABILITY

It is the legislative body's intent that the provisions of this ordinance are to be severable and that if a part of this ordinance is to be invalid, the findings do not necessarily invalidate the entire ordinance.

SECTION 4-UNCONSTITUTIONALITY

Should any part of this ordinance be void or unconstitutional, the remaining ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5-EFFECTIVE DATE


This ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication according to law.




