3. **Coloring Book Project:**

- Committee Member Janet Edwards noted that increased participation in the coloring book project is encouraged. The book will include mayors, directors, magistrates, and additional officials such as council members and the Judge Executive. A total of 100 copies will be produced and bound at a cost of \$6.00 each, with a proposed sale price of \$10.00 per copy to generate profit for the city. Edwards advised she is waiting to hear back from the Masons.
- Additionally, discussion included organizing an essay contest for high school and college students, with proceeds from the coloring book project to be used to fund awards for first, second, and third place winners. It was suggested that winners be announced at the KBBW event on July 25, 2026, and that city-issued certificates be provided.

4. **2026 Calendar of Events / 250th Anniversary of the United States**

- The committee discussed preliminary planning for events recognizing the 250th anniversary of the United States and the 25th anniversary of 9/11. Vice Chairperson Eric Hauser offered to contact available resources to assist with planning, and a tentative budget of approximately \$500.00 was considered.
 - Potential events included a screening of *Ghost Bridge*, a possible haunted hayride (with noted liability concerns), and incorporating the 250th anniversary theme into spring and summer events, including the KBBW event in July.
 - Additional ideas included a musical component featuring the “OG Polka” score, which Committee Member Janet Edwards sent to the Christian County Band Director to have rendered.
 - Committee Member Isaiah Spencer spoke about Juneteenth-related activities, including events with vendors, merchandise, potential live jazz music, and a proclamation reading at the schoolhouse.
 - The committee agreed to meet monthly, with the next meeting scheduled for April 10 at 9:30 AM.
