CALL TO ORDER

- Mayor Jacqueline Oliver called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

OPENING CEREMONIES

- Andy Walters spoke before the mayor and council about public safety, addressing concerns related to speeding and speed limit signage.

Mayor Oliver:

- Reported that Director Ahart indicated all paving projects have been completed. He stated the following streets were submitted for the 2026 TC-2041 grant-Carneal Lane, Bumpus Mills, Good Hope Cemetery Road, Hugh Hunter Road, Hunter Owens Court, Copper Drive, Arrow Circle and Linda Drive. He also advised that the meter changeouts were going well and he hopes those changeouts are completed by the end of April.

- Mayor Oliver also read aloud Director Egbert's report which provided the city council with updates on the Tyler Technologies software process, the audit process, and the scheduling of budget meetings.

Eric Hauser:

- He stated that Hip-Hop classes are no longer being offered. The center served 136 individuals during the Easter Egg Hunt event. Spring Break is currently underway for the kids, with a dodgeball tournament scheduled for this month, along with an upcoming resource fair and Feeding America.

LT. Jeff Locklear:

- Reported that the police department received 1,723 calls for service in the month of March, including 36 criminal cases, 8 injury-related accidents, 28 non-injury accidents, 34 arrests, and 54 hours and 15 minutes of alcohol-related incidents. He also advised that the police department is doing everything they can to help aid in the traffic congestion currently happening due to construction on 124.
