AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY, REPEALING ORDINANCE 1984-10 RELATING TO THE CONTROL OF NOISE WITHIN THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS the City of Oak Grove finds it beneficial to repeal this ordinance to improve the organization of ordinances and eliminate inconsistencies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAK GROVE, KENTUCKY, ORDINANCE 2026-XX IS HEREBY ADOPTED AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I- REPEALING OF ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 1984-10, enacted on the 5th day of September 1984, providing for control of noise within the city, is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION II- SAVINGS CLAUSE

Permits prosecution for violations of the ordinances listed in Section I, provided the violation(s) occurred during the period the ordinances were in effect.

SECTION III- SEVERABILITY CLAUSE

The legislative body intends that this ordinance's provisions are severable and that the findings do not necessarily invalidate the entire ordinance if a part of it is invalid.

SECTION IV- EFFECTIVE DATE

According to law, this ordinance shall take effect after its passage and publication.
